Prime Lambs		
Prime lambs sold to solid competition, with the heavier end attracting the strongest interest. Brooklands Farm Ltd topped the market at \$330 for 8 lambs, while Gower Terrace Farm Partnership sold 8 lambs at \$312 and B F Carmichael & D Drake sold 5 lambs at \$302. Other major lines included I M & A L Fleming with 54 lambs at \$301 and 21 lambs at \$299, Fitzallan Park Ltd with 41 lambs at \$262 and 33 lambs at \$274, and Casey & Sons with 24 lambs at \$268 and 27 lambs at \$237. Prime Sheep		
Prime sheep met steady demand, with ewes selling to a top of \$326 and most of the better lines trading from \$260 to \$324. R & J Adams Partnership sold prime ewes to \$290, B F Carmichael & D Drake reached \$302, while Brooklands Farm Ltd sold at \$324. Prime Cattle		
PRIME STEERS Prime steers met a slightly easier market than recent weeks, although well-finished cattle continued to attract strong buyer interest. Cresslands Farm topped the section at \$3,543 for South Devon steers, while Brosnan Partnership sold Angus steers to \$3,700 and Double Corner Farm sold Angus steers to \$3,320. Most of the better-finished steers sold from 507c/kg to 539c/kg, with a handful of heavier cattle reaching the mid-540c/kg range. Top Price - \$3,700 Steer Range - \$1,638 - \$3,700 PRIME HEIFERS Prime heifers were also back on recent levels, however quality cattle remained in good demand. Brosnan Partnership topped the section at \$2,975, with further lines making \$2,872 and \$2,859. Other notable sales included Daniel MacDonald at \$2,639, Cresslands Farm at \$2,475 and K D & C M Norton at \$2,330, with the better-finished heifers generally selling around 470c/kg to 519c/kg. A small offering of cows and bulls came forward, with demand strongest for well-finished stock. Stoneybrooke Farm topped the cow section at \$2,856, while J M Storer topped the bulls at \$3,633. Westrand Land Ltd sold an Angus bull at \$2,739 and R E & C M Hardwick sold a Shorthorn bull at \$2,903, with cows selling from \$1,872 to \$2,856.
