Prime Lambs		
Prime lambs sold to steady demand, with the better-finished heavy lambs continuing to attract strong competition. Brent Macaulay topped the market at \$380 for 8 ewe lambs, while W I Esson sold 17 lambs at \$338 and Emma Smith sold 2 lambs at \$320. Major lines included Motunau Pamu Ltd with 104 lambs at \$267, 87 lambs at \$255 and 21 lambs at \$270, while Fitzallan Park sold 101 lambs at \$266 and 34 lambs at \$277. Bampton Ag Ltd also sold strongly with 23 lambs at \$307 and 18 lambs at \$277. Top Price - \$380 Heavy - \$280 - \$380 Medium - \$240 - \$279 Light - \$220 - \$239		
Prime Sheep		
Prime sheep sold to solid competition, with a small offering of ewes meeting good demand. Springer Farming topped the ewe section at \$302 for 9 head, followed by a further line at \$294, while D R Taylor sold 7 ewes at \$246. A single ram from Springer Farming sold for \$210. Ewes - \$200 - \$302 Rams - \$210		
Store Lambs		
A small yarding of store lambs sold well with good weights. The Wattles from Little Akaloa had a line of shorn ewe lambs that sold for \$216 at \$6.22/kg.		
Prime Cattle		
PRIME STEERS Prime steers sold to steady demand, with the market similar to last week and the better-finished cattle continuing to attract strong competition. Mount Pleasant topped the section at \$3,657 for 6 head, as well as 2 head at \$3,012. A M Dolan & J H sold steers to \$2,989 and \$2,557. Well-finished steers generally sold from 508c/kg to 531c/kg, with heavier cattle reaching 532c/kg. Top Price - \$3,657 Steer Range - \$1,488 - \$3,657 PRIME HEIFERS Prime heifers were met with strong competition, with quality cattle again attracting plenty of interest. Mount Pleasant topped the section at \$2,872, while also seeling another heifer at \$2,698. Glenlea Partnership sold Angus heifers at \$2,598 and Friesian heifers at \$2,501, while Stuartfield Farm sold Belgian Blue heifers to \$2,761.
