Prime Lambs		
Prime lambs sold to strong competition, with Ellesmere Tiling and Terry Ashley topping the market at \$350. Major lines included I M & A L Fleming with 49 lambs at \$341, Glenrowan Cropping with 51 lambs at \$332 and 18 at \$318, while Fitzallan Park sold 98 lambs at \$284 and a further 25 at \$277. Prime Sheep		
Prime sheep met strong demand, with Ellesmere Tiling topping the ewe section at \$360, followed by Brent Macaulay at \$350 and Glenn Steetskamp at \$344. Moorpark Farm sold ewes at \$290, while Mt Palm sold 12 ewes at \$282. Store Lambs		
Store lambs sold to strong competition, particularly for quality ewe lambs. A C & L K Christey topped the section at \$328 and sold a further line of 18 ewe lambs at \$304, while The Wattles sold 43 ewe lambs at \$234. H M Patterson sold 54 ewe lambs at \$210 and 76 at \$180, with demand easing as quality and weight reduced. Top Price - \$328		
Prime Cattle		
PRIME STEERS Prime steers sold to steady competition, with well-finished cattle attracting the strongest interest. Double Corner Farm topped the section at \$3,090, with further lines returning \$3,003 and \$3,002 per head, while J S & K J C Taylor sold steers to \$2,983. Better prime steers generally traded from 491c/kg to 522c/kg. Top Price - \$3,090 Steer Range - \$1,612 - \$3,090		

PRIME HEIFERS

Prime heifers met solid demand, with quality cattle continuing to sell well. L J Hulston topped the section at \$2,999, while A S & A C Chaffey sold heifers to \$2,858 and a line of five heifers at \$2,767 per head. Glenlea Partnership also sold strongly, with Angus heifers returning \$2,570 and larger lines making over 500c/kg.
