



### Prime Lambs

A solid yarding of prime lambs sold to strong demand throughout the sale, with the top end of the market performing particularly well. The top price of \$322 was shared by CDP & EM Smith and Riverview Partnership, both achieving outstanding results on their better lines, with Riverview also making \$312 for their second pen. TD Gilbert topped the opening pens at \$298 for their 17 head, with GE Morris also performing strongly across multiple lines at \$241–\$299. Fitzallan Park Limited presented the largest draft of the sale with 109 head across two lines making \$228–\$267, while JA Carroll sold three lines from \$170–\$298 and KJ O’Loughlin returned \$221–\$250 across 57 head. La-Mac Stud Limited and RD & LJ Potts also contributed well-presented lines making \$219–\$298 and \$231–\$269 respectively.

### Prime Sheep

A solid yarding of prime ewes and rams sold to excellent demand, with the top end of the market performing very well. The top price of \$310 was achieved by Brosnan Partnership, who were the standout vendor of the day with four lines of prime ewes selling from \$170–\$310, reflecting outstanding presentation across all weights. AC & LK Christey also performed strongly, topping at \$302 for their 8-head pen with further lines making \$192–\$290, while TAD & CM Beaton sold three lines from \$210–\$290 and Grafton Farming Company returned \$249–\$286 across multiple lines. AR Davidson’s 2 wethers made a sharp \$292 and Steve Hartley’s single prime ewe also returned a solid \$290. Rams sold to a good trade with Acheron Holdings Ltd topping at \$260 for their better lines, Inverloch Farm making \$104–\$158 across three lines, and JA & CH Ferguson’s 2th ewes returning \$162.

### Prime Cattle

Prime cattle sold to excellent results at Canterbury Park today, with strong competition across all classes from steers through to bulls. Steers were the standout of the sale, with Duthie Farm topping at \$5.15/kg on their 7-head pen of Hereford steers averaging 535kg, and BA & JS Stewart also performing strongly with multiple lines making \$4.91–\$5.03/kg across Angus and Angus X lines. LP Stratford, A Hanning and BA Sheat & CP Wilson Partnership all contributed well-presented lines making \$4.85–\$5.00/kg. Heifers also sold to a pleasing trade, with MW Johns’ Angus heifers topping the category at \$5.05/kg, and Duthie Farm, CW & JM Flanagan and BA Sheat & CP Wilson Partnership all returning \$4.85–\$4.97/kg on well-finished lines. Cows were firm with HD & K Fraser and EF & PR Belworthy making \$3.70–\$3.96/kg, while bulls rounded out the sale with Stonybrook Farm Limited’s Charolais bull topping at \$4.92/kg on a 785kg beast.
