Prime Lambs		
Prime lambs sold to strong competition throughout the sale, with the heavier end continuing to attract solid buyer interest. Helensvale Farm topped the market at \$361 for 6 lambs, while D H & S M Rhode and Beachcroft Farm both sold strongly at \$330. The major lines included Wedderburn Farm with 134 lambs at \$300, 71 lambs at \$289, and 38 lambs at \$287, while Fitzallan Park sold 55 lambs at \$288 and 38 lambs at \$284. Motunau Pamu Ltd also featured prominently with 43 lambs at \$275, 34 lambs at \$291, and 27 lambs at \$282. Top price - \$361 Heavy - \$280 - \$361 Medium - \$240 - \$279 Light - \$181 - \$239		
Prime Sheep		
Prime sheep sold to solid demand, with a small yarding of ewes, 2th ewes and rams meeting consistent competition. Loch Ard Ltd topped the market at \$288 for 3 prime ewes, while D A & D M Pankhurst and I P Chamberlain both sold quality lines at \$282. I P Chamberlain's 2th ewes also returned \$282, while the ram section topped at \$192 from D H & S M Rhode, with other rams making \$162-\$186. Top price - \$288 Heavy - \$280 - \$288 Medium - \$180 - \$279 Light - \$162 - \$179 Rams - \$162 - \$192.		
Prime Cattle		
PRIME STEERS Prime steers sold to strong competition, with quality cattle continuing to attract solid buyer support. K & S O'Neill topped the market at \$5.64/kg for a 615kg Charolais steer, while Glenlea Partnership sold Angus steers at \$5.57/kg, \$5.53/kg, and \$5.48/kg. Four Diamond Stud also sold strongly at \$5.51/kg, with L P Stratford returning \$5.40/kg for a Hereford steer. Steers - \$5.40 - \$5.64/kg PRIME HEIFERS Prime heifers sold to strong competition, with quality Angus and Hereford heifers attracting solid buyer support. K & S O'Neill topped the market at \$5.50/kg for 2 Charolais heifers averaging 492.5kg, while Glenlea Partnership sold an Angus heifer at \$5.37/kg. D W & C A Ewers sold Hereford heifers at \$5.42/kg and \$5.38/kg, while Motunau Pamu Ltd returned \$5.33/kg and \$5.29/kg for larger lines of heifers. Heifers - \$5.05 - \$5.50/kg		

PRIME BULLS

A small entry of prime bulls sold to solid competition. Four Diamond Stud topped the section at \$5.48/kg for a 655kg Red Poll bull, while Surrey Downs Partnership sold Angus bulls at \$5.36/kg and \$4.98/kg. Other Surrey Downs Angus bulls returned \$4.28/kg and \$4.00/kg.
